Diamond Nation has established COVID-19 policies and procedures which is very fluid and may be adjusted based on the COVID-19 global pandemic and emergency needs. This plan can also be viewed on the Diamond Nation website (www.diamondnation.com). Diamond Nation will adjust this plan as needed due to State and Federal guidelines and CDC recommendations.

We at Diamond Nation want you to know that we value the safety and well-being of our customers. For this reason, we ask that you take the time to read through the following polices that we have put into place to help keep everyone healthy and safe.

We ask all families to actively participate in at home self-screening. Parents or caregivers are required to monitor their children for signs of infectious illness every day. Please take note of whether your child(ren) or anyone in your household has been in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 10 days.

If, during a Diamond Nation function, you become aware that your child is a close contact of someone with COVID-19, we ask that you immediately follow CASE 2 outlined below.

FACE COVERINGS

Players and staff are encouraged to wear masks while indoors. There are no suggestions at this time for masking while outdoors.

PARENTS INSIDE THE FACILITIES

We are asking parents to stay in their cars whenever possible if their child is practicing indoors. There are no suggestions at this time for attending outdoor practices.

CLEANING

Diamond Nation takes pride in daily cleaning and disinfecting of the facility. We will ensure that each day the "touch" areas of the facility are disinfected, and the bathrooms are fully maintained. In addition, we will use a disinfecting electronic spray machine as needed.

RETURNING TO DIAMOND NATION ACTIVITIES AFTER TESTING POSITIVE FOR COVID-19, DISPLAYING COVID-19 SYMPTOMS, OR HAVING COVID-19 EXPOSURE

CASE 1: If a player or employee tests positive for COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status:

The player or employee must:

- Stay home for 5 days from the date of onset of symptoms or a positive test result (if symptoms did not develop): and
- If the player or employee had a fever, at least 24 hours must have passed since the resolution of their fever without the use of fever-reducing medications; and
- All other symptoms must have significantly improved upon returning on day 6. If not, stay home until symptoms have significantly improved.

CASE 2: If a player or employee is directly exposed to someone with COVID-19:

The player or employee must:

- Wear a well-fitting mask around others for 5 days.
- If they develop symptoms, stay home and get tested. If negative test result, stay home until symptoms have significantly improved. If positive test result, see CASE 1 instructions.
- If testing cannot be done, the player/employee is considered positive starting 5 days after date of exposure and should then follow CASE 1 instructions. (Please try to avoid this situation as it could cause an unnecessary minimum 10-day quarantine)

**Due to fixed costs, we cannot guarantee a refund for time closed due to COVID-19.

Duration of closures will be made on a case-by-case basis based on the most up-to-date information about COVID-19 and the specific situation in our community.

If you decide to pause your child's attendance, for any reason, Diamond Nation is unable to prorate tuition or refund.
